

APCM Amersham Deanery Synod Report 2026

The Amersham Deanery Synod meets quarterly and in person in various churches in the Deanery. Peggy Ludlow had her last year Area Dean, retiring at the end of 2025. Lawrence Tebboth (Jenny's husband) continues as the Lay Chair. There have been some interesting presentations and discussions this year, including updates from the General Synod.

At the June 2025 meeting, the final accounts for 2024 of the Amersham Deanery Trust were presented as well as the budget for 2025. Amersham and Coleshill, and Penn and Tylers Green presented their Mission Action Plans, as well as explaining their processes and how they use them within their parishes.

At the September 2025 meeting, there was an update from General Synod, video updates from the Paulsons about their work in Honduras, and a presentation by Peter Ladd from CARE about the Assisted Dying Bill, followed by an opportunity to ask him questions.

At the November 2025 meeting, Julie Dziegiel went through the Parish Share allocations within the Deanery. There was also a presentation about an Anglican Giving survey, covering the attitudes, behaviours and insights around giving and generosity.

Jez did a presentation about Trinity Café, explaining why we started the café, how it is going and what impact it has had. Michael Cooper did a presentation about Samaritan's Purse, their work and what they do, covering disaster relief, medical ministries, clean water, women at risk and the Christmas boxes for children.

The new Area Deans are Rev'd Jonny Rapson as Area Dean, and Rev'd Lucy Fyfe-Jamison and Rev'd Christoph Linder as Associate Area Deans.

The March 2026 meeting was cancelled.
